

Table S4. Primary-to-secondary conceptual co-occurrence (exploratory)

Cell values are counts of records ($n = 208$ with a discernible secondary dimension); rows are primary categories, columns secondary. PP = policy process; CPA = critical power analysis; IGP = interest group politics; SM = social movements; PEW = political economy & welfare state; EN = ethics & normative; GA = governance & accountability; O = other. Secondary codes were not finally adjudicated and are reported only at the aggregate level. The adjacency structure was highly consistent across the two independent coders (Spearman $\rho = 0.97$; six of seven strongest pairs shared).
