

Table S7. Most frequent publication venues and their conceptual profiles

Publication venues with at least four included records ($N = 457$), ordered by frequency; cell values are counts of records by primary conceptual category. PP = policy process; GA = governance & accountability; IGP = interest group politics; SM = social movements; CPA = critical power analysis; PEW = political economy & welfare state; EN = ethics & normative; O = other. The 457 records appeared in 271 distinct journals after normalization of title variants; the ten most frequent venues together accounted for 128 records (28.0%), whereas 214 of 271 journals (79.0%) contributed a single record. The most frequent venues were the *Journal of Health Politics, Policy and Law* ($n = 36$; 7.9%), *Social Science & Medicine* ($n = 27$; 5.9%), and *Global Public Health* ($n = 12$; 2.6%). Conceptual usage was patterned by venue: the applied policy-and-politics journals (*Journal of Health Politics, Policy and Law*; *Health Affairs*; *Health Economics, Policy and Law*; $n = 46$) were 52% policy process versus 7% critical power analysis, a balance nearly reversed in the critical and social-scientific venues ($n = 16$; 12% vs. 88%), including *Critical Public Health* (6 of 7), *Anthropology & Medicine* (3 of 3), and *Sociology of Health & Illness* (3 of 3), while *Social Science & Medicine* ($n = 27$) spanned both poles together with social movements. A systematic analysis of all 271 journals is beyond the scope of the review.
